

PLC Strategic Planning Committee Meeting
March 1, 2018
Notes

1. Suzanne shared updates from the three other Strategic Planning committees, particularly the idea to seek a bond issue for the construction of a single high school/middle school complex with a counseling center, technology improvements, and upgrades to some buildings to facilitate consolidation and offer additional programs.
2. We envisioned the structure of PLCs in consolidated buildings where there would be more teachers to collaborate both horizontally and vertically.
3. We discussed how best to identify teacher leaders for PLCs (per department at secondary and per grade level at elementary).
 - o Kaitlin suggested informing teachers about what the role entails/means.
 - o We discussed the need to determine the structures of PLCs (north and south, entire district, by building, etc.) in order to assign leaders.
 - o Suzanne will work on fleshing out these details.
